Ways God Speaks

- 1) The Ways God Speaks: Prophetically-Hearing God-rarely audible; Spirit to spirit. Speaking in tongues is a great way to “grow” your spirit [Jude 1:20]
 - a. Words/Speaking – 2 Peter 1:21: *But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture becomes a matter of someone’s own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God*
 - i. Hearing-words of knowledge-something that is currently true about a person or their past. [Acts
 - ii. Words of wisdom-knowing what to do [Genesis 41;1-36-Joseph after interpreting Pharaoh’s dream knew how to deal with the situation]
 - iii. Prophetic word-foretelling or forthtelling: Agabus [Acts 21:11], Paul [Acts 27:10] John the Baptist [announcing Jesus], Jesus, all the prophets [Amos 3:7] Matthew 7:21-23 (Many will say to Me, ‘Lord, Lord’...)
 - iv. Writings, scripture-2 Timothy 3:16: must value the written word above all.
 - v. Matthew 10:41-The one who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet’s reward.
 - b. Seeing-pictures, images in our spirit
 - c. Feeling
 - d. Knowing aka Discernment [Acts 27:10-Paul “perceived” they would shipwreck]
 - e. Songs & music-Psalms
 - f. Arts-painting, drawing, digital, jewelry, sculpture, etc [Exodus 28:3; 31:6,35:10,25;36:8]
 - g. Dance & movement-Psalms, King David
 - h. Testimony-Revelation 19:10
 - i. Acts
 - i. Jesus partnered with the prophetic each time He said what was going to happen or He obeyed the Father by doing a physical act that He asked Him to do. His baptism; Mark 1:38, 8:31; He rebuked Peter for speaking against what Jesus was foretelling. John 9:39; 10:10; 12:46
 - ii. Partnering with God’s promises and the prophetic word in this season*
 - j. Numbers
 - k. Breadcrumbs and/or treasure hunt-4 am; time→
 - l. Events-OT/coming of Jesus, His life and the events surrounding it
 - m. Dreams-Joseph, Jacob
 - n. Visions-Acts 18:9, 16:9
 - o. Nature-DNA
 - p. Angels
 - q. Prophetic lifestyle
